Sir

It would, in our opinion,
be well if the Provincial Govern-
ment reserved Harwood (Savary
and Cortes Islands in the Gulf of
Georgia, until the land claims
of the Klathouse and other
neighbouring Indians are settled,
also all the islands in the Fraser
River lying opposite to the Matsqui
village and near the SW of
Township 7, New Westminster district.

Looking to the number of Indians
in Buxley Sound and that ne-
bours had and also at Salmon River
The Honourable The
Chief Commissioner of Lands & Works
Victoria

which flows into Johnston's Strait, are
 recommended under section on the
 part of the Provincial Government
 in reference to land at the head
 of the Alborzi Canal from that
 place to the mountains, and also
 the land in the Salmon River
 valley.

The Alborzi land is
 within the railway belt.

Judging from letters that
 have reached us from Mr
 Duncan I.P. and others, it
 might, further, be advisable,
 pending the settlement of Indian
 land questions, not to give any

right to lands on the Mass and Skeena
 must submit to the occupation rights
 of the Indians.
