CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION.

THE INVINCIBLE MINING COMPANY,

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, hereby certify (in duplicate) that we desire to form, under the provisions of the "Companies' Act, 1878," and amending Acts, a Company as hereinafter mentioned:

1. That the corporate name of the said Company shall be "The Invincible Mining Company, Limited Liability."

1st.
